

Lambruk Solar Project Career Expo Sponsorship

The Lambruk Solar Farm will use NSW's abundant sunlight to generate clean renewable energy to power approximately 180,000 homes. The facility would be located at Loomberah, 15km south-east of Tamworth.

If approved, the state significant development would provide employment for up to 350 people during construction including trades, engineers, project managers, plant and heavy vehicle operators, labourers, administration, safety and environmental roles, security, cleaners, fencers, traffic control, landscapers as well as other indirect jobs and opportunities through the supply chain.

There will also be up to 15 full-time jobs once the solar farm is operational.

The facility would operate for up to 30 years and generate substantial

environmental and economic benefits.

The facility would have the capacity to generate up to 500MW (DC) and 300 MW (AC) as well as use battery storage to feed electricity into the grid at times of high demand to improve grid stability.

We focus on improving the readiness of First Nation students to transition from school to further education and/or employment improving linkages between schools and pathways to further education and/or employment by establishing community-based partnerships with schools, VET training providers, ranger groups, Traditional Owners and local Elders.

Post School Support Officer

The Post School Support Officer (PSSO) program aims to provide assistance to young Aboriginal people who are in the final stages of their high school journey or post high school with their transition to independence, and success in sustaining training or employment. The Post School Support Officer program has a focus on establishing strong relationships with high schools, industry ties, employer and training partnerships. The program can provide assistance and information on:

- Understanding emerging industries;
- Skills shortage and employment trends; and
- Work with the Tamworth Local Aboriginal Land Council programs to provide wrap around services primarily with the Opportunity Hub.

Aboriginal Community Connector Program

The Community Connector initiative is led by the Coalition of Aboriginal Peak Organisations (CAPO) as part of the Premier Priority on Aboriginal Education and Culture in partnership with the Department of Education and Premier and Cabinet.

The priority aims to increase the proportion of Aboriginal students attaining their HSC by 50% while maintaining their cultural identity. The Aboriginal Community Connector:

Meets with students at school, home or anywhere they feel comfortable to have a chat

- Talks to students about their passions, goals and some of the challenges they may be experiencing at school or in their life that keep them from engaging in education
- Works with students and their family to develop a tailored plan that helps students address the challenges they are experiencing so they can reach their goals
- Build students confidence and cultural connections so they have a strong foundation to realise their potential in education and in life.



Tamworth Regional Astronomy Club

A new Science and Astronomy Centre with a multi-function auditorium accommodating up to 200 people for live presentations with extensive displays of meteorites, minerals, megafauna, astronomical images and items of scientific interest.

The centre houses 3 observatories. An adjoining roll-off roof observatory houses multiple large telescopes for public viewing nights, including one of the largest privately-owned telescopes in Australia. Also adjoining the auditorium is a 6.7-metre domed observatory which has a dual function as a planetarium theatre for simulated night sky views and audio-visual presentations.

The complex includes a purpose-built, split-roof observatory for the historic Hewitt Camera, one of only two built by the British military in the 1950s costing 5.5 million pounds to track missiles and satellites and later used for astronomical research at Siding Spring Observatory.

One of the Science and Astronomy Centre's purposes is to promote S.T.E.M. principles and inspire students and youth into technology-related career paths. The Centre is run by volunteers who come from all walks of life from technology and science backgrounds.

Lambruk Solar Project Career Expo Sponsorship

The Lambruk Solar Farm will use NSW's abundant sunlight to generate clean renewable energy to power approximately 180,000 homes. The facility would be located at Loomberah, 15km south-east of Tamworth.

If approved, the state significant development would provide employment for up to 350 people during construction including trades, engineers, project managers, plant and heavy vehicle operators, labourers, administration, safety and environmental roles, security, cleaners, fencers, traffic control, landscapers as well as other indirect jobs and opportunities through the supply chain.

There will also be up to 15 full-time jobs once the solar farm is operational. The facility would operate for up to 30 years and generate substantial environmental and economic benefits.
